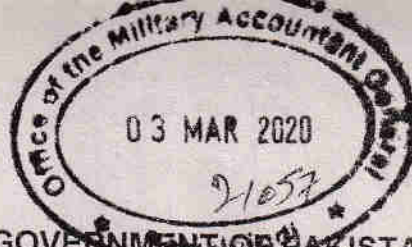

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Subject: SUBMISSION OF SUMMARIES TO THE CABINET

The Prime Minister has been pleased to observe that Ministries/Divisions have been submitting summaries to the Cabinet without following the procedure laid down in Rule 18 of the Rules of Business, 1973. Since the summaries submitted to the Cabinet do not adhere to the requirements provided under the Rules of Business, 1973, the result is unnecessary delays thereby adversely affecting good governance. Following observations have been noted and it has been directed that the same may be brought to the knowledge of the Secretaries of all Ministries/Divisions:

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a. Summaries do not mention the provision of law/rules/regulation/instructions under which approval/order of the Cabinet is required;

b. Summaries, involving more than one Ministry/Division, are submitted without fulfilling the requirements of Inter-Ministerial consultations as envisaged in Rules 8, 10-14A of the Rules of Business, 1973;

c. Summaries, requiring submission of draft bills, Ordinances or Orders before the Cabinet, do not adhere to the requirements of Rule 18(4) & 18(5) of the Rules of Business, 1973;

d. Summaries, requiring in principle approval of a proposed legislation, shall bring out clearly the main issues to be legislated upon as required under Rule 18(2) of the Rules of Business, 1973. The difference between submission of bills/Ordinances/Orders before the Cabinet and submission of cases requiring in principle approval of a proposed legislation needs to be appreciated and dealt

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
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accordingly in terms of Rule 18(2) and 18(5) of the Rules of Business, 1973 respectively;

2. The Prime Minister has further been pleased to observe that it is the duty of the administrative Secretaries of the concerned Divisions/Ministries for observance of these rules as provided in Rule 5(9)(g) of the Rules of Business, 1973. Thus, it is expected from the Secretaries to not only adhere to these rules but also guide their respective Ministers for the purposes of good governance based on the principles of due process and rule of law.

3. The Prime Minister has also been pleased to direct the Cabinet Secretary that summaries, which do not meet the requirements of the Rules of Business, 1973, shall be returned to the concerned Secretaries with reasons under intimation to the Office of the Prime Minister.


