- iii. Authorize review of current policies, programs, and initiatives in the TVET sector to identify prevalent weaknesses and development of plans for leveraging technology to address these issues;
- iv. Approve mechanisms for quality assurance, accreditation, and certification of vocational training programs and institutions;

- v. Approve monitoring and evaluation frameworks to track performance, and impact of technical and vocational training institutes;
- vi. Approve guidelines for the development, standardization, modernization of technical and vocational training curricula in industry (domestic and international) requirements and international best practices;
- vii. Approve programs for the professional development, training, and capacity building of vocational instructors, trainers, and educators;
- viii. Approve plans for curbing exploitation of skilled workers, HIV/AIDS and illegal emigration; and
- ix. Authorize action plans for engagement with relevant bilateral and multilateral partners and for

The Cabinet Committee may co-opt any person as a member and may invite any person by special invitation if it deems appropriate.

No act, decision or proceeding of the Cabinet Committee shall be invalid on account of absence, vacancy or defect in the constitution of the Committee.
